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Plaintiff is cautioned that when service of a complaint is not made upon a defendant within 120 days after the complaint was filed, the court may be required to dismiss the plaintiff's claims against that defendant. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(m).

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The Clerk of the Court is directed to send plaintiff one summons, one USM-285 form, an instruction sheet, and a copy of the complaint filed October 30, 2008;
- 2. Within thirty days from the date of this order, plaintiff shall complete the attached Notice of Submission of Documents and submit it to the court with the documents listed below:
 - a. One completed USM-285 form for defendant Geringson;
 - b. Two copies of the endorsed complaint filed October 30, 2008; and

c. One completed summons form.

Failure to do so will result in a recommendation that defendant Geringson be dismissed from this action. In the alternative, plaintiff may file a request to voluntarily dismiss defendant Geringson.
