13 Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis with an action  
14 filed pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On August 24, 2009, defendants filed a motion (Doc. 30) for  
15 an extension of time to file their initial responsive pleading, to which plaintiff filed an  
16 opposition. On August 31, 2009, plaintiff filed a motion for default (Doc. 32) as defendants had  
17 not filed responsive pleadings.

18 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

19 1. Defendants motion for an extension (Doc. 30) is granted in part, and  
20 defendants have an additional thirty days, to and including September 23, 2009, to file their  
21 initial responsive pleading.
