18 This matter came before the Honorable Judge Dale A. Drozd on
 19 plaintiff United States' ex parte motion for default judgment.
 20 There was no appearance by or on behalf of any other person or
 21 entity claiming an interest in the defendant jet ski to oppose
 22 plaintiff's motion. Based on plaintiff's motion and the files
 23 and records of the court, THE COURT FINDS as follows:

24 1. This action arose out of a Verified Complaint for
 25 Forfeiture In Rem filed December 17, 2008.

26 2. Plaintiff United States of America has moved this Court,
 27 pursuant to Local Rule A-540, for entry of default judgment of
 28 forfeiture against potential claimant Linsey Moore.

1 3. Plaintiff has shown that a complaint for forfeiture was
2 filed; that the government attempted to personally serve and
3 provide notice to Linsey Moore; that potential claimant Linsey
4 Moore was provided notice of the forfeiture action through her
5 attorney of record, David W. Dratman; that any and all other
6 unknown potential claimants have been served by publication; and
7 that grounds exist for entry of a final judgment of forfeiture.

8 Therefore, IT IS RECOMMENDED as follows:

9 4. That Linsey Moore be held in default;


10 5. That plaintiff's motion for default judgment and final
11 judgment of forfeiture be granted;

12 6. That a judgment by default be entered against any right,
13 title or interest of potential claimant Linsey Moore in the
14 defendant jet ski;

15 7. That a final judgment be entered, forfeiting all right,
16 title and interest in the defendant jet ski to the United States
17 of America, to be disposed of according to law; and

18 8. That the Default Judgment and Final Judgment of
19 Forfeiture lodged herein be signed by the Honorable Frank C.
20 Damrell, Jr. and filed by the Clerk of the Court.
