16	Petitioner, confined in a county correctional center, proceeds without counsel and seeks a
17	writ of habeas corpus. See 28 U.S.C. § 2254. This case is before the undersigned pursuant to
18	petitioner's consent. See 28 U.S.C. § 636; see also E.D. Cal. Local Rules, Appx. A, at (k)(1)-(2).
19	On June 2, 2009, the court dismissed petitioner's third amended petition for failure to
20	specify the grounds for relief in his petition and for failing to file a petition that is complete in
21	itself without reference to any prior petitions. See Rule 2(c), Rules Governing § 2254 Cases;
22	E.D. Cal. L.R. 15-220. The court gave petitioner 30 days to file a fourth amended petition
23	correcting those deficiencies and warned petitioner that failure to file an amended petition would
24	result in dismissal.
25	On July 13, 2009, petitioner filed 74 pages with the court, consisting of filings from the

1	this action as well as another action, No. 08-cv-3027 GGH), and copies of several cases decided
2	by the California Supreme Court. However, the 30-day period has expired and petitioner has not
3	filed an amended petition or otherwise complied with the court's order.

4 Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that this action is dismissed. *See* Rules 2(c), 4,

5 Rules Governing § 2254 Cases.
