Doc. 24

Plaintiff has included in his objections a motion for an extension of time to file "a more complete and consice [sic] answer" to the magistrate judge's findings and recommendations. (Pl.'s Objections at 2.) Plaintiff has articulated his objections, and the court has conducted a <u>de novo</u> review of the case. Plaintiff's motion for an extension of time of unspecified length is therefore denied.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. Plaintiff's request for an extension of time to file more complete objections is denied as unnecessary;
- 2. The findings and recommendations filed March 12, 2010 (Doc. No. 22) are adopted in full;
- 3. Defendant Bauman's May 29, 2009 motion to dismiss (Doc. No. 7), in which all other defendants have joined, is granted;
 - 4. Plaintiff's complaint is dismissed with prejudice; and
 - 5. The Clerk of the Court is directed to close the case.
