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Joshi, et al v. Starbucks Corporation

Plaintiffs Rakesh Joshi and Pranika Joshi ("Plaintiffs") and defendant Starbucks Corporation ("Starbucks"), through their respective counsel (collectively, the "Parties"), submit the following stipulation:

WHEREAS on January 12, 2010, Plaintiffs filed a Notice of Acceptance of Starbucks' Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 68 Offer of Judgment to pay Plaintiffs Four Hundred Thousand and NO/100 Dollars (\$400,000.00) in damages on Plaintiffs' breach of contract cause of action;

WHEREAS the Offer of Judgment also required Starbucks to pay Plaintiffs for reasonable attorneys' fees, and related nontaxable expenses and costs Plaintiffs incurred in connection with this lawsuit;

WHEREAS on January 12, 2010, pursuant to the Offer of Judgment, this Court entered an interlocutory judgment awarding Plaintiffs Four Hundred Thousand and NO/100 Dollars (\$400,000.00) in damages on Plaintiffs' breach of contract cause of action;

WHEREAS the only remaining issue before the Court is determining the amount of Plaintiffs' reasonable attorneys' fees, related nontaxable expenses and costs;

WHEREAS the Parties have reached an agreement as to an agreed-upon amount of reasonable attorneys' fees, related nontaxable expenses and costs to be awarded Plaintiffs;

WHEREAS, the Parties agree that Plaintiffs shall be awarded One Hundred Eighty-Four Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-Two and 49/100 **Dollars** (\$184,322.49) as reasonable attorneys' fees, related nontaxable expenses and costs.
