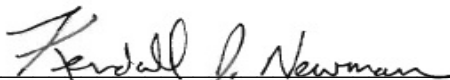
In order to promote the expeditious resolution of this action, defendants are directed to re-serve plaintiff with their motion to dismiss/summary judgment motion.
