17 Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, brings this civil rights action pursuant
18 to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff has not, however, filed a complete application to proceed in
19 forma pauperis, along with a certified copy of his prison trust account statement for the six-

22 either a completed application to proceed in forma pauperis or the appropriate filing fee.
23 Plaintiff is warned that failure to resolve the fee status of this case within the time provided may
24 result in the dismissal of this action for lack of prosecution and failure to comply with court rules
25 and orders. See Local Rule 11-110.
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Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Plaintiff shall submit on the form provided by the Clerk of the Court, within 30 days from the date of this order, a complete application for leave to proceed in forma pauperis, with the required certified copy of his prison trust account statement, or the appropriate filing fee; and

2. The Clerk of the Court is directed to send plaintiff a new form Application to Proceed In Forma Pauperis By a Prisoner.
