Plaintiff is a prisoner proceeding pro se with an action under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The court finds appointment of counsel is warranted. Stephen M. Duvernay, Ashley H. Joyce, and Alex M. Medina, who have been selected from the court’s pro bono attorney panel, are hereby appointed.

They have represented that they are preparing an engagement letter regarding the provision of services, and their appointment as counsel shall be contingent on defendant executing the engagement letter and returning it to appointed counsel.

1 Appointed counsel shall file a written notice with the court upon plaintiff's satisfactory execution
2 and return of an engagement letter to them.
