16	Petitioner Shannon Secrease is a state prisoner proceeding through counsel with a petition
17	for writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. The petition for writ of habeas corpus
18	sets forth twenty-four grounds for relief, which includes one unnumbered claim. Grounds one
19	through ten, and the unnumbered claim, are ineffective assistance of counsel claims.
20	Additional information alluded to but not provided by Respondent in his Answer is likely
21	necessary to fully address Petitioner's ineffective assistance of counsel claims. Respondent
22	provides: (1) the May 15, 1998, transcript showing that a Marsden ¹ hearing was scheduled for
23	May 28, 1998, and that a hearing on Petitioner's motion for a new trial was scheduled for June

1	18, 1998, Resp't's Answer Ex. B, pt. 7, at 9; (2) the minute order of the May 28, 1998, Marsden
2	hearing, Resp't's Answer Ex. A, at 201; (3) the minute order of the June 18, 1998, appearance on
3	the motion for a new trial that was rescheduled for "setting" on July 27, 1998, <i>id.</i> at 213; and (4)
4	the July 27, 1998, transcript of the hearing on the motion for a new trial, Resp't's Answer Ex. B,
5	pt. 8. Transcripts were not provided for the May 28, 1998, Marsden hearing and the June 18,
6	1998, appearance on the motion for a new trial.
7	IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
8	1. Respondent shall file a copy of the transcript for the May 28, 1998, Marsden hearing;
9	2. Respondent shall file a copy of the transcript for the June 18, 1998, appearance on the
10	motion for a new trial; and
11	3. Respondent shall file the above documents within fourteen days of the date of this
12	order.
