

	1	WHEREAS, on August 16, 2010, the Court issued a Stipulation and Order Modify			
	2	Second Amended Status Order (Docket #87), amending and establishing discovery, motion,			
	3	pretrial, and trial dates in this matter so as to allow the Parties to continue to settlement			
	4	discussions;			
	5	WHEREAS, for the period from August 16, 2010 to the present, the Parties have			
	6	continued to engage in substantive settlement discussions;			
	7	WHEREAS, during those settlement discussions, the Parties agreed to postpone discovery			
	8	and other trial preparation in the case pending the outcome of those discussions;			
	9	WHEREAS, the Parties have agreed to undertake an independent assessment of portions			
	10	of Defendants' MS4 program;			
	11	WHEREAS, the intent of the independent assessment is to provide a basis for the Parties			
	12	to reach a final settlement to be entered by the Court;			
	13	WHEREAS, the Parties anticipate that the independent assessment will not be completed			
	14	for approximately six months;			
	15	WHEREAS, the Parties desire to stay all pretrial proceedings and vacate all dates set by			
	16	the Stipulation and Order Modifying the Second Amended Status Order, pending completion of			
	17	the independent assessment and good faith efforts by the Parties to reach a final settlement; and			
	18	WHEREAS, notwithstanding the stay, the Parties desire to retain the ability to reinitiate			
	19	litigation in the event performance of the independent assessment becomes unreasonably delayed			
	20	or otherwise fails.			
	21	NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and among the Parties that:			
	22	1. All proceedings in this action shall be stayed.			
	23	2. All dates set by the Stipulation and Order Modifying the Second Amended Status			
	24	Order (Docket #87) shall be vacated.			
	25	3. A status conference will be held on August 17, 2011 to inform the Court of the

	27	4. During the period this case is stayed, any Party may reinitiate litigation by giving			
	28	two-weeks' notice of its intent to do so to the Court and the other Parties.
