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| 1  | 1. The findings and recommendations filed February 22, 2012, are adopted in                        |
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| 2  | full.  |
| 3  | 2. Defendants' motion to dismiss (Dkt. No. 22), is granted in part, and denied in                  |
| 4  | part.  |
| 5  | 3. Plaintiff's state law claims ("causes of action" two through five), and federal                 |
| 6  | claims for injunctive and declaratory relief, are dismissed without leave to amend.                |
| 7  | 4. This action shall proceed only on plaintiff's federal damages claims under                      |
| 8  | Section 1983 ("cause of action" one), against the current defendants (Ryan, Bourland, Nunez,       |
| 9  | Chavarria, Anaya, Rush, and Price).  |
| 10 | 5. Plaintiff is granted leave to file and serve, within thirty (30) days after the date            |
| 11 | of this order, an amended complaint that clearly alleges, against the appropriate defendants, only |
| 12 | those federal claims addressed in the findings and recommendations. The amended complaint          |
| 13 | shall be limited in length to twenty (20) pages, and should be typed and double-spaced. Failure    |
| 14 | of plaintiff to timely file and serve an amended complaint that conforms to these parameters shall |
| 15 | result in the dismissal of this action.  |
