16	Petitioner is a state prisoner proceeding, pro se, with a petition for writ of habeas corpus
17	pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. In his claims, Petitioner argues that he was incompetent to stand

19	June 7, 2011 and lodged several documents including the Clerk's Transcript. The California
