FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding without counsel in an action brought under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On September 23, 2009, the court found that the complaint stated a cognizable claim as to defendant Clanton but not as to any other defendant. The court gave plaintiff 20 days to submit materials for service of process on defendant Clanton, or, alternatively, 30 days to file an amended complaint to attempt to state cognizable claims against additional defendants.

The times for acting have passed and plaintiff has not submitted the materials necessary to serve process, nor has he filed an amended complaint or otherwise responded to the September 23, 2009, order.¹

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¹ Although it appears from the file that plaintiff's copy of the order was returned, plaintiff was properly served. It is the plaintiff's responsibility to keep the court apprised of his current address at all times. Pursuant to Local Rule 182(f), service of documents at the record address of the party is fully effective.
