7	4. Plaintiff's motion for outside care filed July 9, 2010 (Docket No. 33) is denied;

9	5. Defendant Jackson's motion to dismiss filed July 6, 2010 (Docket No. 30) and
10	joined by defendant Hibbits on November 8, 2010 (Docket No. 47) is denied.
