to five (5) pages and shall include the following:

1) the party's assessment of whether the instant action is of the type that would benefit from a settlement proceeding;

1	2) the party's assessment of what factors, if any, will prevent settlement of this matter
2	prior to trial; and
3	3) any additional information the court may find useful in determining whether to set this
4	matter for a settlement conference.
5	Should the Court determine this action to be appropriate for referral to the Prisoner
6	Settlement Program, the Court will set this matter for settlement conference before a magistrate
7	judge or district judge.
