16 Plaintiff, currently confined at the Rio Cosumnes Correctional Center (“RCCC”),
17 is proceeding pro se with a civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Although plaintiff
18 has filed an application to proceed in forma pauperis, plaintiff’s application does not include a
19 certified copy of plaintiff’s trust account statement for the six-month period immediately
20 preceding the filing of the complaint in this action or an RCCC official’s certification. See 28
21 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(2). Plaintiff’s incomplete application will be denied with leave to file a
22 properly completed application to proceed in forma pauperis.


Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1 2. Plaintiff shall submit, within thirty days from the date of this order a properly
2 completed in forma pauperis application that includes a certified copy of plaintiff's trust account
3 statement for the six-month period immediately preceding the filing of the complaint in this
4 action and an RCCC official's certification; plaintiff is cautioned that failure to comply with this
5 order or seek an extension of time to do so will result in a recommendation that this action be
6 dismissed without prejudice; and

7 3. The Clerk of the Court is directed to send plaintiff an Application to Proceed
8 In Forma Pauperis By a Prisoner for use in a civil rights action.
