
On August 25, 2009, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein which were served on all parties and which contained notice to all parties that any objections to the findings and recommendations were to be filed within twenty days. Neither party has filed objections to the findings and recommendations.

The court has reviewed the file and finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by the magistrate judge’s analysis. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1 1. The findings and recommendations filed August 25, 2009, are adopted in full;
2 2. Petitioner's June 24, 2009 motion for a stay and abeyance (Doc. No. 9) is
3 granted;
4 3. Petitioner's June 24, 2009 motion to amend (Doc. No. 10) is granted;
5 4. Petitioner is ordered to present all unexhausted claims to the California
6 Supreme Court in a further state habeas corpus petition to be filed within thirty days;
7 5. This action is stayed and the Clerk of the Court is directed to administratively
8 close the case;
9 6. Petitioner is ordered to file and serve a status report in this case on the first
10 court day of each month; and
11 7. Petitioner is ordered to file and serve a motion to lift the stay of this action,
12 along with a proposed second amended petition containing only exhausted claims, within thirty
13 days after petitioner is served with the California Supreme Court's order disposing of the state
14 exhaustion petition.
