v. Housewright, 900 F.2d 1332, 1335-36 (9th Cir. 1990). The court finds that there are no exceptional circumstances in this case.

On January 12, 2011, the court granted plaintiff's request for an extension of time to file and serve an amended complaint in accordance with the court's October 27, 2010 order. Dckt. No. 30. The court informed plaintiff that he could seek another extension of time if his medical condition has not improved. In his request for counsel, plaintiff claims that is still unable to control his hands to use a pen or a pencil. The court will therefore grant plaintiff another extension of time to file an amended complaint.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that plaintiff's February 23, 2011 request for appointment of counsel is denied, and plaintiff's February 23, 2011 request for an extension of time is granted. Plaintiff has 30 days from the date this order is served to file and serve an amended complaint in accordance with the court's October 27, 2010 order.
