17 Pursuant to the Stipulation for Final Judgment of  
 18 Forfeiture, the Court finds as follows:

19 1. This is a civil forfeiture action against Approximately  
 20 \$635,486.07 in U.S. Currency (hereafter "defendant currency").

21 2. A Verified Complaint for Forfeiture *In Rem* was filed on  
 22 May 21, 2009, seeking the forfeiture of the defendant currency,  
 23 alleging that said property is subject to forfeiture to the  
 24 United States of America pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 881(a)(6).

25 3. On or about May 22, 2009, the Court issued a Warrant for  
 26 Arrest for the defendant currency, which was duly executed on May  
 27 27, 2009.

28 4. Beginning on May 29, 2009, for at least 30 consecutive

1 days, the United States published Notice of the Forfeiture Action  
2 on the official internet government forfeiture site  
3 [www.forfeiture.gov](http://www.forfeiture.gov). A Declaration of Publication was filed on  
4 June 30, 2009.

5 5. In addition to the public notice on the official  
6 internet government forfeiture site [www.forfeiture.gov](http://www.forfeiture.gov), actual  
7 notice or attempted notice was given to the following  
8 individuals:

9 a. Ryan Louis Ennis

10 b. David M. Michael (attorney for Ennis)

11 6. On June 18, 2009, Ryan Louis Ennis filed a verified  
12 claim alleging an ownership and/or possessory interest in, and  
13 the right to exercise dominion and control over the defendant  
14 currency.

15 7. Apart from claimant Ryan Louis Ennis, no other party has  
16 filed a claim or answer in this matter, and the time for which  
17 any person or entity may file a claim and answer has expired.

18 Based on the above findings, and the files and records of  
19 the Court, it is hereby ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

20 1. The Court adopts the Stipulation for Final Judgment of  
21 Forfeiture entered into by and between the parties to this  
22 action.

23 2. That judgment is hereby entered against claimant Ryan  
24 Louis Ennis and all other potential claimants who have not filed  
25 claims in this action.

26 3. All right, title and interest of claimant Ryan Louis  
27 Ennis in the defendant currency shall be forfeited to the United  
28 States pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 881(a)(6), to be disposed of

1 according to law.

2 4. That plaintiff United States of America and its  
3 servants, agents, and employees and all other public entities,  
4 their servants, agents, and employees, are released from any and  
5 all liability arising out of or in any way connected with the  
6 seizure, arrest, or forfeiture of the defendant currency. This  
7 is a full and final release applying to all unknown and  
8 unanticipated injuries, and/or damages arising out of said  
9 seizure, arrest, or forfeiture, as well as to those now known or  
10 disclosed. The parties waive the provisions of California Civil  
11 Code § 1542.

12 5. Claimant Ryan Louis Ennis waived any and all claim or  
13 right to interest that may have accrued on the defendant currency  
14 being forfeited to the United States.

15 6. All parties are to bear their own costs and attorneys'  
16 fees.

17 7. The Court shall maintain jurisdiction to enforce the  
18 terms of this Final Judgment of Forfeiture.
