The 30-day period has expired and plaintiff has not filed a complaint or paid the required filing fee or requested leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* or otherwise responded to that order.

Although plaintiff filed a document on December 29, 2009, it is unresponsive to the

Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that the Clerk randomly assign a United States District Judge to this case.

Further, it is RECOMMENDED that this action be dismissed without prejudice.

These findings and recommendations are submitted to the United States District Judge assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(l). Within fourteen days after being served with these findings and recommendations, any party may file written objections with the court and serve a copy on all parties. Such a document should be captioned "Objections to Magistrate Judge's Findings and Recommendations." Failure to file objections within the specified time may waive the right to appeal the District Court's order. *Turner v. Duncan*, 158 F.3d 449, 455 (9th Cir. 1998); *Martinez v.
