By order filed on July 2, 2010, plaintiff was granted an extension of time of twenty-eight days to file an amended complaint. On July 9, 2010, in a note directed to the court clerk, plaintiff enclosed the form the clerk's office had apparently sent to him, returning his amended complaint because plaintiff had failed to provide a case number. In the note, plaintiff indicates that, on July 1, 2010, he separately returned the amended complaint to the court, after he had applied the case number to it.
