

To the extent plaintiff makes claims of discrimination and violation of his rights under the Equal Protection Clause of the Fourteenth Amendment by any prison policy of integrated housing for sensitive needs yards inmates against any defendants, those claims are dismissed and the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation and High Desert State Prison, Warden Felker and Warden McDonald, as well, are dismissed as defendants in this action.
