19 Pursuant to the Stipulation for Final Judgment of Forfeiture,
 20 the Court finds as follows:

21 1. This is a civil forfeiture action against Approximately
 22 \$6,200.00 in U.S. Currency ("defendant currency") and a 2000 Nissan
 23 Maxima, VIN: JN1CA31D2YT747576, California License Number: 6CNZ606
 24 ("defendant vehicle").

25 2. A Verified Complaint for Forfeiture *In Rem* ("Complaint")
 26 was filed on July 2, 2009, alleging that the defendant currency
 27 and defendant vehicle are subject to forfeiture to the United
 28 States of America pursuant to 21 U.S.C. §§ 881(a)(4) and

1 881(a)(6).

2 3. On or about July 2, 2009, the Clerk issued a Warrant for
3 Arrest for the defendant currency and defendant vehicle, and that
4 warrant was duly executed on the defendant currency on July 7,
5 2009, and on the defendant vehicle on July 21, 2009.

6 4. Beginning on August 20, 2009, for at least 30
7 consecutive days, the United States published Notice of the
8 Forfeiture Action on the official internet government forfeiture
9 site www.forfeiture.gov. A Declaration of Publication was filed
10 on September 21, 2009.

11 5. In addition to the public notice on the official
12 internet government forfeiture site www.forfeiture.gov, actual
13 notice or attempted notice was given to the following
14 individuals:

15 a. Jose Ramon Delgadillo

16 b. Juan Carlos Favela Castro

17 6. On August 6, 2009, Claimant Jose Ramon Delgadillo
18 ("Delgadillo") filed a Claim of Ownership in Property Under
19 Warrant of Seizure. On August 14, 2009, Claimant Delgadillo
20 filed an Amended Claim of Ownership in Property Under Warrant of
21 Seizure. On August 25, 2009, Claimant filed an Answer to the
22 Complaint. No other parties have filed claims or answers in this
23 matter, and the time for which any person or entity may file a
24 claim and answer has expired.

25 7. The Clerk of the Court entered a Clerk's Certificate of
26 Entry of Default against Juan Carlos Favela Castro on October 15,
27 2010. Pursuant to Local Rule 540, the United States and Claimant
28 thus join in a request that as part of the Final Judgment of

1 Forfeiture in this case the Court enter a default judgment
2 against the interest, if any, of Juan Carlos Favela Castro
3 without further notice.

4 Based on the above findings, and the files and records of
5 the Court, it is hereby ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

6 1. The Court adopts the Stipulation for Final Judgment of
7 Forfeiture entered into by and between the parties to this
8 action.

9 2. That judgment is hereby entered against claimant Jose
10 Ramon Delgadillo and all other potential claimants who have not
11 filed claims in this action.

12 3. All right, title, and interest of Claimant Jose Ramon
13 Delgadillo in the defendant Approximately \$6,200.00 in U.S.
14 Currency, together with any interest that may have accrued on
15 that amount, shall be forfeited to the United States pursuant to
16 21 U.S.C. § 881(a)(6), to be disposed of according to law.

17 4. All right, title, and interest of Claimant Jose Ramon
18 Delgadillo in the defendant 2000 Nissan Maxima, VIN:
19 JN1CA31D2YT747576, California License Number: 6CNZ606, shall be
20 forfeited to the United States pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 881(a)(4),
21 to be disposed of according to law.

22 5. That plaintiff United States of America and its
23 servants, agents, and employees and all other public entities,
24 their servants, agents, and employees, are released from any and
25 all liability arising out of or in any way connected with the
26 seizure, arrest, or forfeiture of the defendant currency and the
27 defendant vehicle, and for the commencement and prosecution of
28 this forfeiture action. This is a full and final release

1 applying to all unknown and unanticipated injuries, and/or
2 damages arising out of said seizure, arrest, or forfeiture, as
3 well as to those now known or disclosed. The parties waived the
4 provisions of California Civil Code § 1542.

5 6. Claimant Delgadillo waived any and all claim or right to
6 interest that may have accrued on the defendant currency being
7 forfeited to the United States.

8 7. All parties are to bear their own costs and attorneys'
9 fees.

10 8. The Court shall maintain jurisdiction to enforce the
11 terms of this Final Judgment of Forfeiture.
