16	Plaintiff, a county prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed a civil rights action	
17	pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 together with a request for leave to proceed in forma pauperis	
18	pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915. However, the certificate portion of the request which must be	
19	completed by plaintiff's institution of incarceration has not been filled out. Also, plaintiff has	
20	not filed a certified copy of his prison trust account statement for the six month period	
21	immediately preceding the filing of the complaint. See 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(2). Plaintiff will be	
22	provided the opportunity to submit a completed in forma pauperis application and a certified	
23	copy in support of his application.	
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In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. Plaintiff shall submit, within thirty days from the date of this order, a completed affidavit in support of his request to proceed in forma pauperis on the form provided by the Clerk of Court;
- 2. The Clerk of the Court is directed to send plaintiff a new Application to Proceed In Forma Pauperis By a Prisoner; and
- 3. Plaintiff shall submit, within thirty days from the date of this order, a certified copy of his prison trust account statement for the six month period immediately preceding the filing of the complaint. Plaintiff's failure to comply with this order will result in a recommendation that this action be dismissed without prejudice.
