20	court will grant respondent's request, but warns that, absent extraordinary circumstances, no
21	further extensions of time will be granted.
22	The court's order of September 13, 2010 is hereby vacated, and it is ORDERED that
23	respondent's September 7, 2010 motion, Dckt. No. 18, is granted and respondent shall file and
24	serve an answer on or before October 14, 2010.
