The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 19 20 On February 25, 2015, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein (ECF No. 92) which were served on all parties and which contained notice to all parties that any 21 22 objections to the findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. Plaintiff 23 has filed objections to the findings and recommendations. In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this 24 Court has conducted a <u>de novo</u> review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire 25 26 file, the Court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by 27 proper analysis. 28 ///// 1

1	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
2	1. The findings and recommendations filed February 25, 2015 (ECF No. 92) are
3	ADOPTED IN FULL;
4	2. Defendant Sotak's March 4, 2014 Motion to Revoke Plaintiff's In Forma Pauperis
5	Status (ECF No. 74) is GRANTED;
6	3. The Court's February 1, 2010 order granting in forma pauperis status (ECF No. 9) is
7	VACATED and Plaintiff's in forma pauperis status is REVOKED; and
8	4. Plaintiff is ordered to furnish the statutory filing fee of \$350 to proceed with this action
9	and is admonished that failure to pay the filing fee within thirty days of this order will result in
10	dismissal of this action.
11	IT IS SO ORDERED.
