18 Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, filed this civil rights action pursuant to 42
19 U.S.C. § 1983 on July 30, 2009. In his complaint, plaintiff alleges violations of his civil rights by
20 defendants. The alleged violations took place in San Joaquin County, which is part of the
21 Sacramento Division of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of California.
22 Therefore, the complaint should have been filed in the Sacramento Division.

23 Pursuant to Local Rule 3-120(b), a civil action which has not been commenced in the proper
24 court may, on the court's own motion, be transferred to the proper court. Therefore, this action will
25 be transferred to the Sacramento Division. This court will not rule on plaintiff's request to proceed in
26 forma pauperis.
