11 Examination of the above-entitled actions reveals that these  
12 actions are related within the meaning of Local Rule 123 (E.D. Cal.  
13 2005). Accordingly, the assignment of the matters to the same  
14 judge and magistrate judge is likely to affect a substantial  
15 savings of judicial effort and is also likely to be convenient for  
16 the parties.

17 The parties should be aware that relating the cases under  
18 Local Rule 123 merely has the result that these actions are

24 1177-KJM-EFB and 2:10-CV-0516-WBS-JFM be reassigned to Judge John  
25 A. Mendez and Magistrate Judge Dale A. Drozd for all further  
26 proceedings, and any dates currently set in the reassigned cases  
27 only are hereby VACATED. Henceforth, the caption on documents  
28 filed in the reassigned cases shall be shown as 2:11-CV-1177-JAM-

1 DAD and 2:10-CV-0516-JAM-DAD.

2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court make  
3 appropriate adjustment in the assignment of civil cases to  
4 compensate for this reassignment.

5 IT IS SO ORDERED.
