15 On November 24, 2010, the undersigned held a hearing on Sierra Pacific Industries'
16 motion to compel production of personnel records of current and former United States Forest
17 Service employees, and for sanctions.

18 For the reasons stated on the record, it is hereby ORDERED that:

19 1. Sierra Pacific Industries' motion to compel is granted in part and denied in part. *See*
20 Dckt. No. 86.

21 2. By December 8, 2010, the United States shall produce all of the personnel records in
22 question, except for Karen Juska's medical records, to Sierra Pacific Industries. The records are
23 produced subject to the August 12, 2010 protective order in this case.

24 3. Also by December 8, 2010, the United States must submit Karen Juska's medical
25 records to the court for *in camera* review.
