16	Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding pro se with a civil rights action pursuant to
17	42 U.S.C. § 1983. On April 29, 2010, the court dismissed plaintiff's complaint with leave to file
18	an amended complaint. Plaintiff filed a request for reconsideration of that order. On May 21,
19	2010, the assigned District Judge affirmed the undersigned's April 29, 2010 order. Plaintiff has
20	not filed his amended complaint; however, in the interest of justice, the court will provide
21	plaintiff with a final extension of time to file his amended complaint.
22	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
23	1. Within thirty days from the date of service of this order, plaintiff shall file an
24	amended complaint as set forth in the court's April 29, 2010 order; the amended complaint must
25	comply with the requirements of the Civil Rights Act, the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, and
26	the Local Rules of Practice; the amended complaint must bear the docket number assigned to this

1	case and must be labeled "Amended Complaint"; plaintiff shall use the form complaint provided
2	by the court; failure to file an amended complaint in accordance with this order will result in a
3	recommendation that this action be dismissed without prejudice; no further extensions of time
4	will be granted for this purpose; and
5	2. The Clerk of the Court is directed to provide plaintiff with the court's form
6	complaint for a § 1983 action.
