16	Petitioner, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed this application for a writ
17	of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. The matter was referred to a United States
18	Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.
19	On February 18, 2011, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations
20	herein which were served on all parties and which contained notice to all parties that any
21	objections to the findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days.
22	Respondent has filed objections to the findings and recommendations.
23	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule
24	304, this court has conducted a <u>de novo</u> review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire
25	file, the court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by
26	proper analysis.
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1	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
2	1. The findings and recommendations filed February 18, 2011, are adopted in

4	2. Respondent's June 24, 2010 motion to dismiss the petition as untimely (Doc.
5	No. 26) is granted in part and denied in part as follows:
6	a. Respondent's motion to dismiss petitioner's second and fourth claims
7	as time-barred is granted; and
8	b. Respondent's motion to dismiss petitioner's first and third claims as
9	time-barred is denied.
