18 Upon consideration of the Secretary's Petition to Enforce Final Agency  
19 Decision filed herein by Hilda L. Solis, Secretary of Labor, United States  
20 Department of Labor, on the 25th day of September, 2009, in which it is alleged  
21 that Respondent FoodPro International, Inc., failed and refused to comply with the  
22 Decision and Order entered on September 4, 2008, by Administrative Law Judge  
23 Steven B. Berlin of the Office of Administrative Law Judges, United States  
24 Department of Labor, now a final agency decision, ordering Respondent to pay  
25 \$47,799.70 in back wages owed to the Wage and Hour Division, U.S. Department  
26 of Labor, 2800 Cottage Way, Room W-1836, Sacramento, California 95825-1886,  
27 plus interest under 26 U.S.C. § 6621(a)(2), and

2 **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:

3 1. That the Secretary's Petition to Enforce Final Agency Decision be and  
4 the same is hereby GRANTED; and

5 2. Pursuant to Rule 58 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Final  
6 Judgment be and the same is hereby entered in favor of Petitioner Hilda L. Solis,  
7 Secretary of Labor, United States Department of Labor and against Respondent  
8 FoodPro International, Inc. As required in the Decision and Order entered on  
9 September 4, 2008, by Administrative Law Judge Steven B. Berlin of the Office of  
10 Administrative Law Judges, United States Department of Labor, now a final  
11 agency decision, Respondent FoodPro International, Inc., is indebted in the amount  
12 of \$47,799.70 to the Wage and Hour Division, U.S. Department of Labor, 2800  
13 Cottage Way, Room W-1836, Sacramento, California 95825-1886, plus interest  
14 under 26 U.S.C. § 6621(a)(2), for all of which let execution issue.
