16	Plaintiff, who is civilly committed, is proceeding without counsel in an action brought
17	under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. He has requested that the court appoint counsel. District courts lack
18	authority to require counsel to represent indigent prisoners in § 1983 cases. Mallard v. United
19	States Dist. Court, 490 U.S. 296, 298 (1989). In exceptional circumstances, the court may
20	request counsel voluntarily to represent such a plaintiff. 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(1); Terrell v.
21	Brewer, 935 F.2d 1015, 1017 (9th Cir. 1991); Wood v. Housewright, 900 F.2d 1332, 1335-36
22	(9th Cir. 1990). The court finds that there are no exceptional circumstances in this case.
23	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that plaintiff's May 6, 2010, request for
24	appointment of counsel is denied.
