- 2. Plaintiff United States of America has moved this Court, pursuant to Local Rule 540, for entry of default judgment of forfeiture against potential claimants Kultar Singh¹ and Rajdeep Kaur.
- 3. Plaintiff has shown that a complaint for forfeiture was filed; that potential claimants Kultar Singh and Rajdeep Kaur received notice of the forfeiture action; that any and all other

5	5. That plaintiff's motion for default judgment and final
6	judgment of forfeiture be granted;
7	6. That a judgment by default be entered against any right,
8	title or interest of potential claimants Kultar Singh and Rajdeep
9	Kaur in the defendant assets;
10	7. That a final judgment be entered, forfeiting all right,
11	title and interest in the defendant assets to the United States of
12	America, to be disposed of according to law.
13	8. That the Default Judgment and Final Judgment of Forfeiture
14	lodged herein be signed by the Honorable Morrison C. England, Jr.
15	and filed by the Clerk of the Court.
