

1 Accordingly, not later than ten (10) days following the date this Order is electronically
2 filed, Plaintiff is required to submit supplemental briefing not to exceed five (5) pages on
3 the following questions: (1) whether and how the operative complaint is actually verified;
4 and (2) how the standard of review applicable to Plaintiff's application for default
5 judgment in this Court is affected by California Code of Civil Procedure 764.010 ("The
6 court shall not enter judgment by default but shall in all cases require evidence of
7 plaintiff's title and hear such evidence as may be offered respecting the claims of any of
8 the defendants, other than claims the validity of which is admitted by the plaintiff in the
9 complaint."). See, e.g., Phelan v. Mecom Equipment, LLC, 2013 WL 1313960, at *4
10 (E.D. Cal. 2013).
