24 1. Rule G(4) of the Supplemental Rules for Admiralty or
 25 Maritime Claims and Asset Forfeiture Actions (hereafter
 26 "Supplemental Rules") provides that the Plaintiff shall cause

1 public notice of the action to be given in a newspaper of general
2 circulation or on the official internet government forfeiture
3 site;

4 2. Local Rule 171, Eastern District of California, provides
5 that the Court shall designate by order the appropriate newspaper
6 or other vehicle for publication;

7 3. The defendant 2005 Haulmark Featherlite Transport DLX
8 Trailer, VIN: 16HGB18226U049374, California License No: 4GU3271,
9 and the defendant 2006 Haulmark Featherlite Transport DLX
10 Trailer, VIN: 16HGB18206U049373, California License No: 4GU3031,
11 (hereafter "defendant trailers") were seized in the city of
12 Nevada City, Nevada County, California. The defendant 2004
13 Toyota Tacoma SR5 Truck, VIN: 5TEWN72N04Z464442, California
14 License No: 7P49605 (hereafter "defendant vehicle") was seized in

9 for the Plaintiff no later than 60 days after the first day of
10 publication on the official internet government forfeiture site;

12 (6) A statement that answers to the Complaint or
13 a motion under Rule 12 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure
14 ("Fed. R. Civ. P.") must be filed and served within 20 days after
15 the filing of the claims and, in the absence thereof, default may
16 be entered and condemnation ordered.


