8 and the defendant 2006 Haulmark Featherlite Transport DLX  
9 Trailer, VIN: 16HGB18206U049373, California License No: 4GU3031,  
10 (hereafter "defendant trailers") were seized in the city of  
11 Nevada City, Nevada County, California. The defendant 2004  
12 Toyota Tacoma SR5 Truck, VIN: 5TEWN72N04Z464442, California  
13 License No: 7P49605 (hereafter "defendant vehicle") was seized in  
14 the city of Smartville, in Nevada County, California. The Drug  
15 Enforcement Administration published notice of the non-judicial  
16 forfeiture of the defendant trailers on July 20, 27 and August 3,  
17 2009, in *The Wall Street Journal*. The Drug Enforcement  
18 Administration published notice of the non-judicial forfeiture of  
19 the defendant vehicle on July 13, 20 and 27, 2009, in *The Wall*  
20 *Street Journal*.

21 4. Plaintiff proposes that publication be made as follows:

22 a. One publication;  
23 b. Thirty (30) consecutive days;  
24 c. On the official internet government forfeiture  
25 site [www.forfeiture.gov](http://www.forfeiture.gov);

26 d. The publication is to include the following:  
27 (1) The Court and case number of the action;

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- 1 (2) The date of the seizure/posting;  
2 (3) The identity and/or description of the  
3 property seized/posted;  
4 (4) The name and address of the attorney for the  
5 Plaintiff;  
6 (5) A statement that claims of persons entitled  
7 to possession or claiming an interest pursuant to Supplemental  
8 Rule G(5) must be filed with the Court and served on the attorney  
9 for the Plaintiff no later than 60 days after the first day of  
10 publication on the official internet government forfeiture site;  
11 and  
12 (6) A statement that answers to the Complaint or  
13 a motion under Rule 12 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure  
14 ("Fed. R. Civ. P.") must be filed and served within 20 days after  
15 the filing of the claims and, in the absence thereof, default may  
16 be entered and condemnation ordered.
