5	sit for her depositions, and if Ms. Moore is able to sit for her deposition, schedule Ms. Moore's
6	deposition for a weekday occurring prior to August 5, 2011. If Ms. Moore is truly not able to sit
7	for her deposition for some material reason other than fatigue, the parties may agree to schedule
8	an informal telephone conference with the undersigned to address whether plaintiff may take the
9	deposition of an appropriate "substitute" witness.
