16	Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed a civil rights action pursuant
17	to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 together with a request for leave to proceed in forma pauperis pursuant to 28
18	U.S.C. § 1915. Plaintiff has not, however, filed his application for leave to proceed in forma
19	pauperis on the form used by this district. Accordingly, plaintiff's application will be dismissed
20	and plaintiff will be provided the opportunity to submit the application on the appropriate form.
21	Plaintiff is cautioned that he must also provide a certified copy of his prison trust account
22	statement for the six month period immediately preceding the filing of his complaint.
23	Plaintiff has also requested the appointment of counsel. The United States
24	Supreme Court has ruled that district courts lack authority to require counsel to represent
25	indigent prisoners in § 1983 cases. Mallard v. United States Dist. Court, 490 U.S. 296, 298
26	(1989). In certain exceptional circumstances, the court may request the voluntary assistance of

1	counsel pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(1). Terrell v. Brewer, 935 F.2d 1015, 1017 (9th Cir.
2	1991); Wood v. Housewright, 900 F.2d 1332, 1335-36 (9th Cir. 1990). In the present case, the
3	court does not find the required exceptional circumstances. Plaintiff's request for the
4	appointment of counsel will therefore be denied.
5	In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
6	1. Plaintiff's application to proceed in forma pauperis (docket no. 2) is dismissed
7	without prejudice;
8	2. The Clerk of the Court is directed to send plaintiff a new Application to
9	Proceed In Forma Pauperis By a Prisoner;
10	3. Plaintiff shall submit, within thirty days from the date of this order, a
11	completed application to proceed in forma pauperis. Plaintiff's failure to comply with this order
12	will result in a recommendation that this action be dismissed without prejudice; and
13	4. Plaintiff's request for the appointment of counsel is denied.
