18	Pursuant to the Stipulation for Final Judgment of	
19	Forfeiture, the Court finds as follows:	
20	1. This is a civil forfeiture action against a 2006	
21	Toyota Tacoma Pickup Truck, VIN: 5TEUU42N36Z218237, California	
22	License Number 8J56630 ("defendant vehicle").	
23	2. A Verified Complaint for Forfeiture In Rem was filed on	
24	October 29, 2009 ("Verified Complaint"), seeking the forfeiture	
25	of the defendant vehicle, alleging that said property is subject	
26	to forfeiture to the United States of America pursuant to 21	
27	U.S.C. § 881(a)(4).	
28	3. On or about November 3, 2009, the Court issued a Warrant	
	1	Final Judgment of Forfeiture

for Arrest of Articles In Rem for the defendant vehicle, and that
 warrant was duly executed on November 18, 2009.

4. Beginning on November 10, 2009, for at least 30
consecutive days, the United States published Notice of the
Forfeiture Action on the official internet government forfeiture
site www.forfeiture.gov. A Declaration of Publication was filed
on December 10, 2009.

5. In addition to the public notice on the official
internet government forfeiture site <u>www.forfeiture.gov</u>, actual
notice or attempted notice was given to the following entities
and individuals:

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a. David Michael Bricknell

b. Stephen A. Munkelt (attorney).

6. On November 12, 2009, David Bricknell filed a verified
Claim Opposing Forfeiture alleging that he is the owner of the
defendant vehicle. On December 3, 2009, David Bricknell filed an
Answer to the Verified Complaint. On March 22, 2010, David
Bricknell filed a Withdrawal of Claim; Consent for Dismissal,
thereby extinguishing his interest in the defendant vehicle.

7. Apart from claimant Bricknell, no other party has filed
a claim or answer in this matter, and the time for which any
person or entity may file a claim and answer has expired.

Based on the above findings, and the files and records ofthe Court, it is hereby ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

The Court adopts the Stipulation for Final Judgment of
 Forfeiture entered into by and between the parties to this
 action.

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2. That judgment is hereby entered against claimant David

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Bricknell and all other potential claimants who have not filed
 claims in this action.

3 3. All right, title and interest of David Bricknell in the 4 defendant vehicle shall be forfeited to the United States 5 pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 881(a)(4), to be disposed of according to 6 law.

7 4. That plaintiff United States of America and its servants, agents, and employees and all other public entities, 8 their servants, agents, and employees, are released from any and 9 all liability arising out of or in any way connected with the 10 arrest, seizure, or forfeiture of the defendant vehicle. This is 11 a full and final release applying to all unknown and 12 unanticipated injuries, and/or damages arising out of said 13 arrest, seizure, or forfeiture, as well as to those now known or 14 disclosed. The parties waive the provisions of California Civil 15 Code § 1542. 16

17 5. All parties are to bear their own costs and attorneys'18 fees.

6. The Court shall maintain jurisdiction to enforce the terms of the Final Judgment of Forfeiture.
