16	Plaintiff is a prisoner, without counsel, suing for alleged civil rights violations. See 42
17	U.S.C. § 1983. This proceeding was referred to this court by Local Rule 302 pursuant to 28
18	U.S.C. § 636(b)(1) and is before the undersigned pursuant to plaintiff's consent. See E.D. Cal.
19	Local Rules, Appx. A, at (k)(4).
20	On August 12, 2010, the court found that the complaint stated cognizable claims as to
21	defendants Lor and Sandoval, but not as to any other defendant. The court gave plaintiff 30 days
22	to submit materials for service of process on defendants Lor and Sandoval, or, alternatively, 30
23	days to file an amended complaint to attempt to state cognizable claims against additional
24	defendants. The times for acting have passed and plaintiff has not submitted the materials
25	necessary to serve process, nor has he filed an amended complaint or otherwise responded to the
26	August 12, 2010 order.
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1	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this action is dismissed without prejudice.
