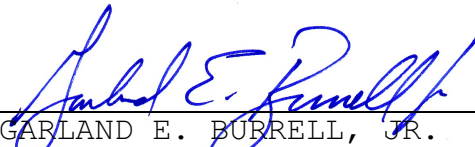
1 The court has reviewed the file and finds the findings and recommendations to be
