16	On January 19, 2010, plaintiff's counsel, Mr. Richard
17	Taguinod, was ordered to show cause why he should not be
18	sanctioned in the amount of \$150.00 for failing to file an
19	opposition brief or notice of non-opposition to defendants'
20	pending motion to dismiss. The court ordered counsel to file his
21	response to the Order to Show Cause on or before February 26,
22	2010.
23	Plaintiff's counsel filed his response to the Order to Show
24	Cause on February 26, 2010, and the court does not find good
25	cause to discharge the Order to Show Cause. Accordingly, the
26	court makes the following orders:
27	1. Mr. Taguinod shall pay sanctions in the amount of
28	\$150.00. Payment should be in the form of a check made
	payable to the Clerk of the Court. The sum is to be

1	paid personally by plaintiff's counsel not later than
2	ten (10) days from the filing of this Order for
3	Sanctions.
4	2. This sanction is personal to the attorney, is to be
5	borne by him personally, and is not to be transmitted
6	to the client by way of a charge of attorney's fees
7	and/or costs.
8	3. Not later than twenty (20) days from the filing of this
9	Order, plaintiff's counsel shall file a declaration
10	attesting to his compliance with the terms of this
11	Order.
