2 they find that they are unable to meet certain portions of the pretrial schedule and therefore
3 mutually request that the Court enter an order modifying certain pretrial and trial deadlines.

4 6. Specifically, the parties request that the following changes be made:

5 a. **Motion Hearings Schedules:**

6 All dispositive motions shall be filed by December 15, 2010. Hearing on
7 such motions shall be on January 12, 2011 at 9:30 a.m. in Courtroom #6.

8 b. **Discovery:**

9 All discovery shall be completed by November 30, 2010.

10 c. **Disclosure of Expert Witnesses:**

11 The parties shall make expert witness disclosures under Fed. R. Civ. P.
12 26(a)(2) by September 15, 2010. Supplemental disclosures and disclosure
13 of any rebuttal experts under Fed. R. Civ. P.26(a)(2)(c) shall be made by
14 September 30, 2010.

15 d. **Pre-Trial Conference:**

16 A Final Pre-Trial Conference shall be held on February 23, 2011 at 3:00
17 p.m. The parties shall file their Joint Pre-Trial Conference Statement not
18 later than February 16, 2011.

19 e. **Trial:**

20 A jury trial shall commence April 4, 2011 at 9:00 a.m.

21 7. Except as otherwise set forth herein, the parties request that the Status (Pretrial
22 Scheduling) Order remain as filed March 8, 2010.
