No objections were filed. 20 Accordingly, the court presumes that any findings of fact are correct. See Orand v. United 21 States, 602 F.2d 207, 208 (9th Cir. 1979). The magistrate judge's conclusions of law are 22 reviewed de novo. See Britt v. Simi Valley Unified School Dist., 708 F.2d 452, 454 (9th Cir. 23 1983). 24 The court has reviewed the applicable legal standards and, good cause appearing, concludes that it is appropriate to adopt the findings and recommendations in full. Accordingly, 25 26 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 27 1. The findings and recommendations (ECF No. 89) are ADOPTED. 28 2. Any claims by the minor plaintiffs (Catherine Belle Gollihar, Anthony Joseph 1

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Gollihar, and Casey Joseph Gollihar) are DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE.

3. Any claim against the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation is DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.
