If the response to the habeas petition is a motion, petitioner's opposition or 11 statement of non-opposition to the motion shall be filed and served within thirty days after 12 service of the motion, and respondents' reply, if any, shall be filed and served within fifteen days 13 thereafter; and 14 5.
