<u>Houston v. Lack</u>, 487 U.S. 266, 108 S.Ct. 2379 (1988). Because plaintiff's objections were constructively filed within 14 days after the findings and recommendations were filed, the court will vacate the September 27, 2012 order and consider the merits of plaintiff's objections.

In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this court has conducted a renewed <u>de novo</u> review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the file, the court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The court's September 27, 2012 order (Doc. No. 59) is vacated;
- 2 The findings and recommendations filed September 10, 2012 are adopted in full;
 - 3. Plaintiff's motion for summary judgment (Doc. No. 35) is denied;
- 4. Defendant's motion to dismiss and for summary judgment (Doc. No. 45) is granted in part, and denied in part, as outlined in the findings and recommendations, and leaving at issue plaintiff's retaliation claim in connection with the August 28, 2008 work re-assignment; and
- 5. This case is referred back to the magistrate judge for setting a further schedule for trial on the remaining retaliation issue.
