2. Defendant Allstate Insurance Company's Alternative Motion for Partial 9 Summary Judgment/Summary Adjudication addressed to plaintiff's claims against it (ECF No. 60) is granted in part and denied in part. Specifically, it is ordered that defendant Allstate Insurance Company is granted summary judgment as to plaintiff's claim for insurance bad faith 12 and the corresponding request for punitive damages, but that the motion for summary judgment 13 is denied in all other respects.
