Plaintiff in this case brings claims relating to former employment with defendant County of Trinity. 2. Hearing on defendants' motion to dismiss (Dkt. No. 8) is CONTINUED to February 22, 2010 at 10:00 a.m.

3. Plaintiff shall file and serve her opposition or statement of non-opposition on or before February 8, 2010. Defendants may file and serve a reply no later than February 16, 2010.
